Kenya

Astride the equator lies Kenya whose very name is synonymous with the safari. Here dramatic game viewing includes the renowned migration during July and August of over a million wildebeest, zebra and gazelle. The Masai Mara National Reserve lying at the edge of the Great Rift Valley is perhaps the most visited of all the African reserves due to the density of game, variety of bird life and the open savannahs.

Amboseli National Park bordering Tanzania and in the shadow of Mount Kilimanjaro is famed for its huge herds of elephant and Lake Amboseli, a temporary lake, that floods during seasons of heavy rainfall. The area is home to a large number of Masai communities whose ancient traditions are still an integral part of their daily life.

Lake Nakuru, which means 'dust or dusty place' in Masai language is famous for its huge flocks of flamingos and Meru National Park was the location of the film 'Born Free'. Here open plains are interspersed with meandering rivers and dense vegetation that is home to a variety of game. Tsavo is one of Kenya's oldest National Parks where volcanic landscapes combine with scrub covered hills and Samburu has verdant riverine forests where some of the rarer species of giraffe and zebra live.

Kenya Highlights

Day 1 - on arrival at Nairobi Airport transfer to your hotel
Overnight and breakfast: Stanley Hotel or similar

Day 2 - drive to Masai Mara game reserve arriving at Mara Sopa lodge in time for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 3 - morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and full board: Mara Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 4 - drive to the southern shores of Lake Naivasha arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon at leisure.

Dinner and overnight: Naivasha Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 5 - drive to Lake Nakuru National Park for full day game and bird watching with a picnic lunch.

Dinner and overnight: Naivasha Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 6 - morning drive to Nairobi for lunch at the African Heritage restaurant then onwards to Amboseli National Park with afternoon game viewing.

Dinner and overnight: Amboseli Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 7 - full day with morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and full board: Amboseli Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 8 - drive to Tsavo National Park watching game en route arriving for lunch at Finch Hatton's Camp. Further game viewing until sunset.

Dinner and overnight: Finch Hatton's Camp or similar

Day 9 - morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and full board: Finch Hatton's Camp or similar

Day 10 - drive back to Nairobi where your tour concludes.

Prices are from £1,340 per person and include accommodation with meals as shown, airport transfers and transport.

Day 1 - from Nairobi Airport transfer to your hotel.

Overnight and breakfast: Norfolk Hotel or similar

Day 2 - drive north through plantations to Sweetwaters Game Sanctuary arriving in time for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Sweetwaters Tented Camp or similar

Day 3 - drive north to Samburu National Reserve arriving in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Intrepids Camp or similar

Day 4 - morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and all inclusive: Samburu Intrepids Camp or similar

Day 5 - drive to Naivasha Sopa Lodge arriving in time for lunch. Your afternoon is at leisure

Dinner and overnight: Naivasha Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 6 - morning drive to Lake Nakuru National Park for a full day game viewing with a picnic lunch, returning late afternoon.

Dinner and overnight: Naivasha Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 7 - drive to Masai Mara National Reserve arriving at Mara Intrepids Camp for lunch and afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Mara Intrepids camp or similar.

Day 8 & 9 - two full days exploring the Masai Mara on morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and all inclusive: Mara Intrepids camp or similar

Day 10 - you will be transferred on a local flight to Nairobi Airport for lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee garden with a tour of Karen Blixen and the Giraffe centre before your flight departure.
