

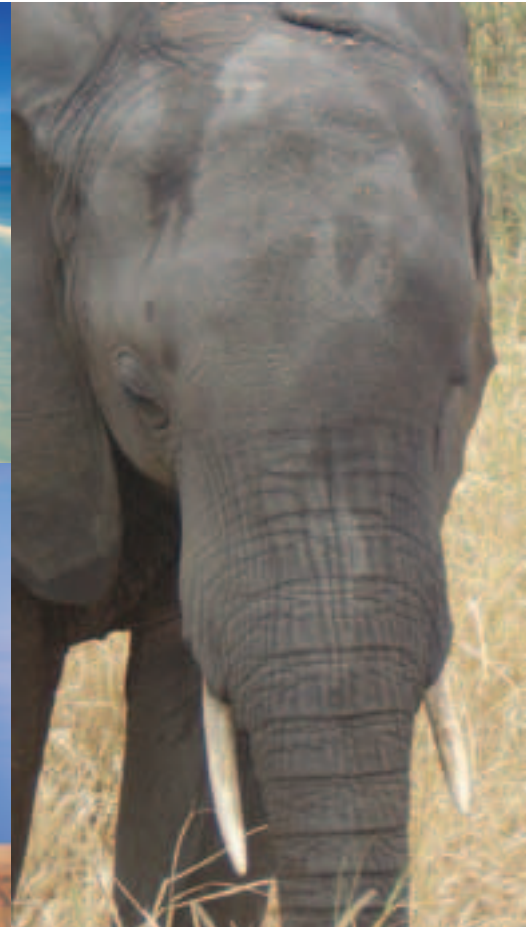

Tanzania & Zanzibar

Tanzania can claim to be the home of the 'safari' meaning 'a journey' in Swahili. Its history is a veritable mosaic of nomadic movement and ethnic diversity. Ancient fossils give clues of earliest man and its history. This unique destination has many wonders including Mount Kilimanjaro, the highest mountain in Africa plus the rich game sanctuaries of the Serengeti, Tarangire, Ruaha and the Marine Park of Mafia Island.

During May and June the annual migration of huge herds of wildebeest, zebra and gazelle as they trek across the Serengeti plains is an awesome spectacle. Equally inspiring is the Ngorongoro Crater, the largest unbroken crater in the world, which forms a vast natural amphitheatre home to huge numbers of animals and pink ribbon of flamingos. Other unique sights are the tree-climbing lions of Lake Manyara National Park, which is also home to large herds of elephant, hippo and buffalo along with over 400 bird species. Further south is the Selous Game Reserve, the largest in Africa, watered by the Rufiji River with its hippo and outsized crocodile along with a rich variety of wildlife and birdlife. After the excitement of a thrilling safari, take time to unwind on a palm-fringed beach and visit the exotic Indian Ocean islands of Zanzibar and Pemba.



Elewana Safari

Day 1 - on arrival in Nairobi you will be taken to the Intercontinental Hotel.

Day 2 - after a short flight to Kilimanjaro Airport you will be met by your driver/guide and taken to the Arusha Coffee Lodge for lunch before continuing to Tarangire Tree Tops for an evening game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Tarangire Tree Tops or similar

Day 3 - enjoy morning and afternoon game drives at Tarangire National Park, home to thousands of elephant and populated in the dry season by game that have migrated from the Masai Mara. This is a bird watchers paradise with a wide variety of resident raptors including the Palmnut Vulture and Fish Eagle.

Overnight and full board: Tarangire Tree Tops or similar

Day 4 - join a local guide for an early morning game walk before returning to the lodge for breakfast and further game viewing before lunch. Departure to Ngorongoro Conservation area, the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. En route see the highly endangered Black Rhino and cross the Great Rift Valley.

Dinner and overnight under canvas! (mobile camp)

Day 5 - an early morning visit to the crater floor (with a packed breakfast) to enjoy searching for black rhino, leopard, waterbuck, zebra and many other species. Return to your overnight mobile camp for lunch and then head north into Serengeti National Park, arriving at Migration Camp in time for a sundowner.

Dinner and overnight: Migration Camp

Day 6 - a full day to experience morning and afternoon game drives in the renowned Serengeti National Park. Serengeti.....'endless plain' in the Masai language is probably the most famous game park in the world! Here you can search the plains and kopjes for leopard, cheetah, lion and other wildlife.

Overnight and full board: Migration Camp

Day 7 - enjoy further game viewing in the Serengeti area. Lunch at your camp and then fly back to Arusha where you will be met and transferred to the Arusha Coffee Lodge, within a mature coffee plantation.

Dinner and overnight: Arusha Coffee Lodge

Day 8 - A morning at leisure. Afternoon transfer to Kilimanjaro Airport for a short flight back to Nairobi where, on arrival, you will be taken to the Carnivore restaurant for a farewell dinner before your flight departure.

Prices are from £2,234 per person, including meals as shown, game activities, local flights and all airport transfers.

Visions of East Africa

Day 1 - upon arrival at Nairobi Airport you will be taken to the Stanley Hotel.

Overnight and breakfast: Stanley Hotel or similar

Day 2 - drive to Amboseli via Namanga to arrive at your lodge which is located in the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro in time for lunch. An afternoon game drive will enable you to view large herds of elephant including impressive tusked bulls.

Dinner and overnight: Amboseli Sopa lodge or similar.

Day 3 - travel to Finch Hatton's for lunch and enjoy an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Finch Hatton's Camp or similar.

Day 4 - full day at your camp with morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight and full board: Finch Hatton's Camp or similar

Day 5 - drive to Taveta where you cross the border into Tanzania. After lunch at an Arusha hotel, drive across Masai country and on to Tarangire National Park with its baobab trees, lovely birds and large groups of elephant and other game.

Dinner and overnight: Tarangire Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 6 - further game viewing around Tarangire National Park. Lunch at your lodge then depart for Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge within the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. En route stop at the edge of Great Rift Valley to get a glimpse of Lake Manyara National Park and the lake.

Dinner and overnight: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 7 - you are driven in a 4x4 vehicle into the Ngorongoro crater floor (World Heritage Site) which has been labelled the Garden of Eden. The crater shelters the most bountiful game in the world including buffalo, leopard, wildebeest, ostrich, impala and many more. Taking a picnic lunch you spend the whole day game viewing and return to Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge.

Dinner and overnight: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 8 - head north stopping halfway for a short visit at Olduvai Gorge 'birthplace of mankind'. Travel onwards into the Serengeti National Park, arguably the most famous game park in the world which covers 14,763 sq km of expansive plains and is the starting point of the annual wildebeest migration. Lunch at Serengeti Sopa Lodge before returning to the park until sunset for more game viewing.

Dinner and overnight: Serengeti Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 9 - morning and afternoon game viewing in Serengeti National Park to capture photos of game including kudu, eland, hyena, waterbuck, crocodile and many more.

Overnight and full board: Serengeti Sopa Lodge or similar

Day 10 - enjoy a short game drive at Serengeti before flying to Arusha where you will be met on arrival and taken to the Arusha Coffee Lodge for lunch. Transfer to Kilimanjaro Airport for your flight to Nairobi and a farewell dinner at Carnivore restaurant, the most famous in East Africa, before your flight departure.

Prices are from £2,234 per person and include accommodation with meals as shown, airport transfers, transport.

Selous and Zanzibar

Day 1 - arrive at Dar es Salaam in the morning where you will be met and taken on a city tour. After lunch at the Royal Palm Hotel, transfer to the airport for a short connecting flight to Selous Game Reserve. On arrival you will be met by your driver/guide and taken to Beho Beho Camp.

Dinner and overnight: Beho Beho Camp

Day 2 - 5 - four full days in your exclusive camp in the north of the Selous Game Reserve where you can choose two daily activities from a selection of game drives in an open safari vehicle, guided walks and a boat safari. This camp in the bush comprises eight spacious Bandas (stone built and palm thatched cottages) with king size beds and large verandahs.

All inclusive: Beho Beho Camp

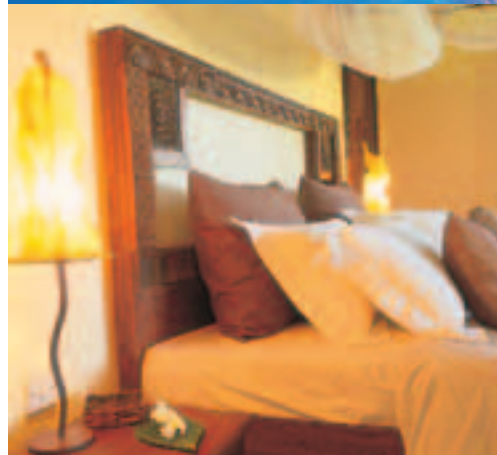
Day 6 - transfer to the airfield for a short flight to Zanzibar where on arrival you are transferred to your resort situated along a pristine beach stretching as far as the eye can see. Half board and overnight: Breezes Beach Club

Day 7 - 11 - five relaxing days for you to stroll along the white sandy beach, dine in candlelight overlooking the ocean and discover the meaning of relaxation.

Half board: Breezes Beach Club

Day 12 - late afternoon transfer to the airport for a 20 minute flight to Dar es Salaam. Upon arrival transfer to Royal Palm Hotel for a farewell dinner before your flight departure.
