Zambia

No trip to Zambia would be complete without visiting the famous Victoria Falls where the mighty Zambezi plunges over 100 metres into a mile wide ravine, best viewed in July and August. The noise and bellowing 'Mosi-oa-Tunya' can be experienced from view points in the rainforests, a thrilling helicopter flight over the Falls or on a relaxing Zambezi cruise. The more adventurous may enjoy white water rafting or the ultimate bungee jump from the bridge above the gorge.

However, this is not the only attraction in this vast country. An abundance of wildlife can be found in Zambia's National Parks. South Luangwa National Park has prolific birdlife and the Luangwa Valley, which marks the end of the Great Rift Valley, is the birthplace of the walking safari. The Luangwa River with its oxbow lagoons is inhabited by vast buffalo and elephant herds as well as being home to the endemic Thornycrofts Giraffe and Cooksons Wildebeest.

Kafue National Park is one of the largest parks in Africa and the open grassy plains, ravine vegetation and woodland contain many wildlife species. The Zambezi River meanders over 2700 km through the Lower Zambezi Valley and is ideal for canoeing safaris.

The Royal Livingstone

Overlooking Victoria Falls in the heart of the World Heritage Site, this magnificent Sun International hotel is located on the banks of the Zambezi River. The deluxe rooms with private verandahs face the river bank and offer a tranquil retreat. International cuisine is served in the dining room or on the terrace.

Prices are from £98 per person per night. Low season special rates are available if staying for three nights or more.



Zambezi Sun

Inspired by traditional African décor, in welcoming earthy tones this Sun International property, along the banks of the Zambezi, has the feel of an old walled city. The rooms have a traditional flavour featuring private balconies and a fold-out couch to accommodate families.

There is a wide array of facilities including an adventure centre, gaming area, curio shops, boma, children's club and a selection of bars and restaurants.

Prices are from £52 per person per night. Low season special rates are available if staying for three nights or more.



Thorntree River Lodge

On the banks of the Zambezi River just 15km upstream from the Falls this lodge commands superb river views from its main deck and private verandahs. Thatched rooms are beautifully appointed blending naturally into the riverside vegetation. Facilities include a pool with bar, dining area and lapa.

This Home of the Elephants offers unique elephant interaction, an elephant back trail, Victoria Falls visits, game drives, fishing and river cruises.

Prices are from £128 full board per person per night.



Sussi & Chuma

An enchanting riverbank hideaway located just ten minutes upstream from the Falls is the setting for ten luxury houses built in the branches of a huge ebony tree. They feature a private verandah with stunning views of the Zambezi River. Amenities include a spectacular raised bar/lounge deck, open air dining area, swimming pool and lawns sweeping down to the water's edge.

Activities include game drives, Victoria Falls excursions, cultural tours plus boat cruises and fishing.

Prices are from £176 full board per person per night.

Best of Zambia

Day 1 - 3 Kapani Safari Lodge - fly by light aircraft from Lusaka to Mfuwe for three memorable nights at Kapani. This lodge is located on a large lagoon beside the Luangwa River and has eight standard suites and two lagoon houses overlooking Kapani Lagoon. Twice daily game viewing is in open vehicles and night drives are a highlight of the Luangwa Valley.

Walking trails from the lodge to two bush camps are also available.

Day 4 - 6 Kayila Lodge - after breakfast, fly by light aircraft from Mfuwe to Kayila for three nights. On the banks of the Zambezi River, overlooking the Mana Pools National Park shoreline, is this exclusive twelve bedded safari lodge. Activities include bush walks with a professional guide, hikes to the nearby escarpment and game viewing by boat.

Day 7 - 9 Thorntree River Lodge - fly by light aircraft to Lusaka then onto Livingstone and transfer by road to this lodge located by the Zambezi River for a three night stay. Enjoy a personal African experience with a wide choice of activities, including elephant trails, river cruises and visits to Victoria Falls.

Day 10 - transfer to Livingstone Airport.

Prices are from £1,875 fully inclusive per person, including all meals, transfers and game activities. Luggage is limited to 12kg per person in soft-sided bags.

Robin Pope Safari

Day 1 & 2 Nkwali Camp - fly from Lusaka to Mfuwe then transfer by road to the South Luangwa where this exclusive safari camp overlooks the park. Entrance into the park is by boat.

This camp has six guest rooms made of woven bamboo and thatch with open-air bathrooms and views of the Luangwa River. There are extensive game and bird species to be enjoyed on game drives, walking safaris and night excursions.

Day 3 - 5 Nsefu Camp - a road transfer to the secluded Nsefu Camp whose six simple rondavels have an air of understated elegance and wooden verandas overlooking the river. A very active waterhole ensures superb game viewing with exhilarating day and night drives and exciting walking safaris.

Day 6 transfer back to Mfuwe for your flight via Lusaka to Livingstone Airport.

Prices are from £1,698 fully inclusive per person, including all meals, transfers and game activities. Luggage is limited to 12kg per person in soft-sided bags.

This tour operates from 01 June to 31 October.

Visions of Zambia

Day 1 & 2 Sussi & Chuma - transfer from Livingstone to your luxury tree house just upstream from Victoria Falls. Activities include game drives, visits to the Falls, boat cruises and fishing.

Day 3 - 5 Lechwe Plains Tented Camp - fly to the World Heritage Wetlands site of Lochinvar National Park where your camp is located by the Chunga Lagoon. See the endemic Kafue Lechwe, numerous plains game and exceptional birdlife. Enjoy game drives, walks, fishing and mokoro trips.

Day 6 - 8 Puku Ridge Tented Camp - transfer by light aircraft to Mfuwe then onwards to the camp. Upon arrival you will be taken on a game drive in the South Luangwa National Park. The Park is known for leopard, lion, elephant, wild dog and giraffe. Game drives and walks are conducted with a professional guide and a National Parks scout.

Day 9 - transfer back to Mfuwe for your flight to Livingstone Airport.

Prices are from **£2,428** fully inclusive per person, including all meals, transfers and game activities. Luggage is limited to **12kg** per person in soft-sided bags.



Two Rivers Safari

Day 1 - 3 Tena Tena - fly from Lusaka to Mfuwe then transfer to South Luangwa National Park which is home to one of the best safari camps in Africa. This remote eight bed tented camp is on a wide bend of the Luangwa River, an area with extensive game and bird species. Enjoy game drives, walking safaris and night excursions.

Day 4 - 6 Chiawa Camp - light aircraft transfer to Lower Zambezi National Park and Chiawa Camp on the banks of the Zambezi River. Under mahogany and acacia trees are eight spacious en-suite tents on platforms, which offer stunning views from your own private verandah. Game viewing is superb with day and night drives, canoe trips, boating and fishing.

Day 7 - transfer back to Mfuwe for your flight to Livingstone Airport.

Prices are from **£2,438** fully inclusive per person, including all meals, transfers and game activities. Luggage is limited to **12kg** per person in soft-sided bags.
